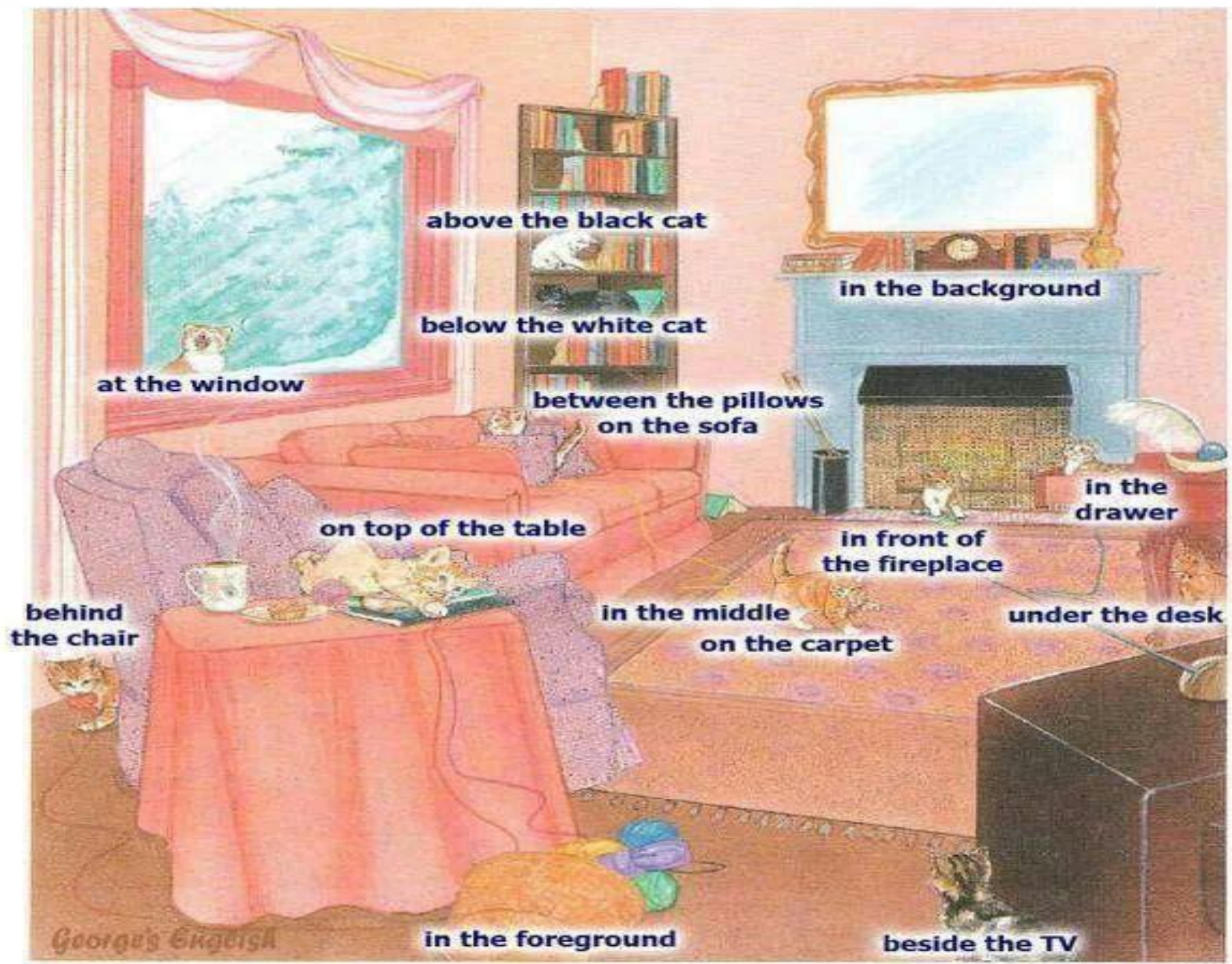


Useful expressions

- **In** the picture there is/are – pildi peal on
- **On** the left (of) there is/are – vasakul on
- **On** the right (of) there is/are – paremal on
- By – ääres
- Next to – kõrval
- Between – vahel
- **In** front of – ees
- **In** the middle (of) – millegi keskel

Useful expressions

- In the (one) corner there is/are – nurgas on
- In the other corner (of) – teises nurgas on
- In the foreground – esiplaanil
- In the background – tagaplaanil
- At the bottom, of the picture – pildi all osas
- Use present continuous while comparing the pictures. This is the moment the pictures were taken.
- If you don't know the term or the name of a building etc, just describe it!
